

Academic Overview

Planned Course of Studies

Edison Prep provides secondary and related special education services to all residents under subcontract with Central Bucks School District and the Bucks County Intermediate Unit. We provided all required courses for graduation as well as selected elective courses. When residents enter contact is made with the former school or schools in order to obtain educational records. Those records are then reviewed to determine what course of study is needed in order for graduation. If special education support services are required those services are also provided.

Our education staff is fully Pennsylvania certified teachers in their subject areas. In addition there is a certified special education teacher and a certified guidance counselor on staff to meet the needs of the residents.

Courses are provided on a daily basis. Classes run from 12:50PM-2:20PM; 2:30PM-4:00PM; 4:30PM-6:00PM and 6:45PM-8:15PM Monday through Thursday. Friday schedule is 9:00AM-10:25 AM; 10:30AM-12:00PM; 1:00PM-2:00PM; 2:00PM-3:00PM and 3:00PM-4:00PM. Students attend most but not all of these sections as each student's schedule is customized to meet his needs.
